Wynne Miller is a life-long coach, whose current work includes management and executive coaching, as well as facilitation of team and management retreats.

A pioneer since her earliest days, Wynne's focus is on the cutting edge of leadership and career management issues. She's been called compassionate and tough minded by clients who welcome her candor, quick mind, incisiveness, humor, and "deceptively simple recipe of wit, wisdom, and love." Drawing on many years as an entrepreneur, educator, trainer, manager, and coach, Wynne uses a wide range of styles and a vast toolkit to produce results with her clients. Wynne has the gift of being present to her clients' needs and provides a safe climate to help them stretch just enough out of their comfort zones to obtain results they are hoping for. As varied as her clients (and their issues) are, the common denominator is that clients uncover the power of their own leadership signature, learning how to enhance their effectiveness while staying true to themselves.

Wynne's background includes being recruited as the sole American to serve on an international team of coaches for a leadership effort at KLM Airlines and later Swisscargo. She was also invited to become the first director of human development for ColorAge, a Massachusetts software company. Wynne has been consultant or coach for a variety of large and small organizations, including MetLife, Philips Medical Systems, OneBeacon Insurance, Thomson Financial Services, and Harvard's Kennedy School of Government. Other notable clients include: Digital Equipment Corporation, Polaroid, New Life Spa (Vermont and British Virgin Islands) and the Massachusetts Audubon Society.

As an entrepreneur, Wynne co-founded Continuum, a career development program for women re-entering the workforce, leaving a lasting legacy with national recognition. After twelve years in the transition business, Wynne recognized the fulfillment of Continuum's mission and had the courage to close the organization, holding true to her belief that organic cycles guide both nature and business. Her next career was in training: designing and delivering workshops in the human potential field, in both the United States and the United Kingdom.

Sought after then for her expertise as a career coach, and now business and leadership coach, Wynne's has appeared on radio and television, demonstrating coaching.

Wynne has been honored by the YWCA as a Woman in Achievement in Business and Industry, and is featured in the book. *Who We Could Be at Work*, in the Butterworth-Heinemann Business Book series. Wynne has been

a speaker for organizations, educational institutions, and professional associations, as well as a featured expert on radio and television.
